

D. Refreshment stop



Extensive and varied veggies and fruit trees, chickens. Neighbour's pretty garden included. Bee expert on location from 10 to noon. Coffee and homemade treats by donation.



- **E.** Diverse year-round garden in medium space. Ecologist with long experience of organic practices.
- **F.** Pretty, pretty, pretty a passionate and highly productive space.



G. Fruit trees, veggies, berries, flowers, art. Creative shade solutions.
